

## 6500lb Stock gas truck pull rules

1. All trucks must be street legal with current registration and insurance.
2. All participants must possess a valid driver's license.
3. Truck can weigh no more than 6500lb.
4. No front end weight allowed. All added weight must be in the bed or in floorboard of vehicle. Flatbeds are allowed.
5. Engine and drive train must be OEM for that vehicle.
6. No headers allowed.
7. The pulling hitch must be no higher than 26 inches from the ground measured to the clevis mounting point, or the highest fixed point of the clevis. A homemade type of clevis is allowed.
8. The opening in the clevis must be at least 3 ½ inches in diameter.
9. The hitch can be from the Reese receiver or some form of a hitch coming from a fifth wheel ball provided the hook point is behind the stock location of the factory bumper.
10. Stock bumpers are required, no push bumpers or any type of bumper that would add more than stock bumper weight.
11. No passengers allowed while pulling.
12. No suspension blocks or traction bars allowed.
13. Absolutely no drivers will be allowed to pull if deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or any other substance.
- 14.. Entry fee is \$20.00 per hook and only one hook per truck per class
15. The puller that is deemed to be the first hook will have the option to take that pull or turn it down and come back 3<sup>rd</sup> or last in the class.  
Each puller has the option if he or she can make an attempt to stop the pulling truck by the 75 foot mark they can back up and try again. Each puller only gets 2 attempts to pull.
16. Anyone acting or driving in an unsafe manner will forfeit any winnings or any other opportunities to compete the remainder of the event.
17. The fair board and any subsequent committees reserve the right to change any rules and all decisions are final.

## 8000lb stock diesel truck pull rules

1. 8000lb maximum weight.
2. No front end weights allowed and any added weight must be in the bed or in the cab.
3. Must have OEM front and rear bumpers or equivalent rear (dmi,cushion hitch), and the number of rear tires must be OEM for that truck.
4. The engine and turbo must be OEM for that truck and that model year.
5. No suspension blocks or traction bars allowed.
6. No barred tires allowed.
7. Driver must possess a valid driver's license and truck must have current registration and insurance.
8. The pulling hitch must be no higher than 26 inches from the ground measured to the clevis mounting point, or the highest fixed point of the clevis. A homemade type of clevis is allowed.
9. The opening in the clevis must be at least 3 ½ inches in diameter.
10. The hitch can be from the Reese receiver or some form of a hitch coming from a fifth wheel ball provided the hook point is behind the stock location of the factory bumper.
11. No passengers allowed while pulling.
12. Absolutely no drivers will be allowed to pull if deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or any other substance.
13. Entry fee is \$20.00 per hook and only one hook per truck per class
14. The puller that is deemed to be the first hook will have the option to take that pull or turn it down and come back 3rd or last in the class.
